



Guidelines for a Safe, Fun and Educational Field Trip Experience

These guidelines have been compiled to ensure that you arrive at the farm prepared for your field trip experience. Hubb's Farm is located on an operating farm and observing these guidelines will help assure you of a safe, relaxed, and thoroughly enjoyable time.

1. Upon arrival to Hubb's Farm, please follow the staff for parking. It is important that you turn in the main drive and make sure the vehicle is not stopped on Hwy 421. Please have the group contact person greet one of our staff when you ARRIVE. Please wait to unload your buses until you are instructed by your contact person.
2. Please BE ON TIME and have PAYMENT READY. If your group is going to be late, please call 910-564-6709 and inform us. If your group is late, you may have to be worked in to an opening.
3. WEATHER AND CANCELLATIONS: Please check weather conditions prior to leaving for the field trip and have your group dress accordingly. If weather is questionable, please call 910-564-6709. This is an outdoor field trip; however, we do have a picnic shelter that the group can get under if it starts to rain after the field trip has started. If we must cancel due to weather, we will make every effort to reschedule your field trip. If you must cancel your field trip for reasons other than the weather, please give us TWO WEEKS NOTICE.
4. Duration of Field Trip: The approximate time of the educational portion of the field trip is 1.5 hours. Larger groups may take longer. After the educational portion of your field trip, Crops of Fun Play Land and our covered picnic area will be available for you. Our farm closes at 2:30P. You may stay at Hubb's Corn Maze up to 4 hours. That should give the groups adequate time for lunch, and additional time to enjoy all the attractions at our Crops of Fun Play Land.
5. FACILITIES: If your group would like to have a picnic lunch or snack, you are welcome to use our facilities which include picnic tables, portable toilets, hand washing stations, and a play area.
6. Wear comfortable, flat-soled shoes. You are coming to a farm.
7. If your group gets pumpkins, teachers may want to bring large boxes to transport the pumpkins for their group back to school.
8. We enjoy having chaperones accompany their children/grandchildren on their field trip to Hubb's Farm. Please inform chaperones prior to arrival that they will be charged for the field trip. We have a limited stocked concession stand during field trips. Snack foods and some microwaveable sandwiches are available.
9. Don't forget to bring your camera to capture all those memorable moments.
10.
