FUN AND EDUCATIONAL

Thank you for planning a Field Trip to Hubb's Corn Maze this Fall. Field Trips can be customized to fit the needs of any group (size or age). We ask that you have at least two dates in mind when booking your trip, that way if one is booked you can go ahead and reserve your time slot for the other. The tours are a great outing for the kids to learn about farm life while enjoying some good old country fun and entertainment. Let us help you customize a tour for your group while meeting the state requirements of a field trip. We will be glad to assist you in identifying how the activities tie to different curriculums. A link to the North Carolina Common Core Standards is provided on the Field Trip Page of our website.

New in 2016

- Our pricing has been updated to include a free pumpkin. Yes all paying field trip customers will get a free pumpkin. Teachers we will even see if we can't find one for you. ;-). If it weren't for you, the kids would not be coming out to our Farm.
- Including in every field trip will be an Educational Station. – Although getting out to the farm is all educational in some form or fashion, this year's rotation will include a station that will be strictly education. The 15-20 class will be dependent upon the age of the students.
- A greenhouse for the group to tour. We have a greenhouse now. We are in the early stages of experimenting with hydroponics here on the farm. It is possible that a portion of the green house will be used for the Educational Station.
- We will be open for Field Trips on Monday, October 31. We had several inquiries last year about October 31, 2016 field trips. This date falls on a Monday (we normally use Mondays for makeup dates

only), so we are planning a special Halloween at the Farm Field Trip day. Additional activities could be announced for that day. These activities may or may not be an additional charge.

- Throughout our Fall Field trip season, we may have special appearances by some local associations that have interesting information in the forms of displays and/or presentations to share. Such honeybee associations, history associations, etc. These will be added to the calendar as they are confirmed. These events are not a guarantee for your visit, however, your chosen date might include an added bonus. Once those dates are announced, we expect the dates to fill up quickly.

FIELD TRIP INCLUDES:

- **Hayride** – Enjoy a ride around our farm and maze. Our hayrides are pulled by tractors and each one has sides. The class will take the hayride to Animal Acre.
- **Animal Acre** – Visit animal acre, where you will have a chance to visit with live animals. You may see the following animals: llama, alpaca, miniature bull, miniature horse, donkey, rabbits and chickens. Not all animals may be available each day, but most will. Please keep in mind that at Animal Acre we do not allow guests to touch the animals as a safety precaution.
- **Hubb's Classroom** – Learn about growing and harvesting crops. You will also learn about different ways that foods are now grown. Children will learn more about the maze and how it is designed and cut.
- **Maze** – Test your skills as you experience the North Carolina themed maze. The 10+-acre maze is cut in 3 different mazes. Each maze has a different level of difficulty. The age of the group will determine the maze that is used. In any of the mazes, an adult must accompany all children. The maze is available for each field trip.
 - Coast Maze – Ages PK and above
 - Includes the INTERACTIVE EDUCATION FARM TRACKS GAME
 - Game Explanation – Last night six farm animals snuck into the house and stole Farmer Joe's apple pie. Farmer Joe chased the animals into the corn maze. He needs you to go into the corn maze and find the tracks. Place the rubbing paper over the track, and use a crayon to rub the track onto the paper. Once you have collected all six tracks come out and look at the banner to find out which animal belongs to the track. Let us know who stole the pie, so that we can catch those pie stealing animals.
 - Includes The FABULOUS FINGER FUNNIES GAME
 - Game Explanation – The goal is to decorate each finger of your right hand with a different color. To do this, guests find five stations hidden in the maze. Each station features a hole filled with non-toxic oil pastel just big enough for a finger. After finding all five stations, you have successfully

colored all your fingers in one of 120 possible combinations. Come out of the maze; find the color combination of your fingers on the banner, then “act out” the FUNNY Act that applies to your combination of colors.

- Blackbeard Maze – Middle School and above
 - Includes the traditional CHECKPOINTS SCAVENGER HUNT
 - Game Explanation – The goal is to find all 6 checkpoints either by wondering through the maze without a map or using the map that is on the punch card. At each checkpoint, there is a unique hole punch. Punch your card and be off to find the next. How quick can you complete this maze? Great as a team play.
- Wild Horse Maze – High School and above
 - Includes the traditional CHECKPOINTS SCAVENGER HUNT.
 - Game Explanation – The goal is to find all 6 checkpoints either by wondering through the maze without a map or using the map that is on the punch card. At each checkpoint, there is a unique hole punch. Punch your card and be off to find the next. How quick can you complete this maze? Great as a team play.
- **Hubb’s Giant Double Barrel Slide** (for safety reasons we ask that at least one teacher must be available to monitor kids at the top of slide)
- **Hubb’s Sand Land**
- **Hubb’s Tire Mountain & Play Area**
- **Hubb’s Giant Pop Jumping Pillow**
- **Straw Bale Maze**
- **Rope Mountain**
- **Play Land** – Large Play area that includes many games such as Human Foosball, Dodge ball and more
- **Education Stations** – areas with colorful educational posters for teachers to review with class.

Allow at least 2 hours for field trip plus approximately an additional hour for lunch/snack and play time.

BASIC PACKAGE FIELD TRIP COST - \$9 per person

Public Schools

- Field Trip cost applies to ALL STUDENTS, PARENTS, and SIBLINGS
- School Employees are free – Teachers, Assistants, Principals, Bus Drivers. So in other words, if you are a school employee (meaning you receive a paycheck from the school), then your admission is free the day of the field trip.
- Must have a minimum of 25 paying to book a field trip.

Home Schools, Preschools, MOPS Groups and any other group that chooses to come during Field Trip Times

- The rate is \$9 per person.
- Children 2 and younger are free with a paying customer.
- Designate a lead person that will collect all money for the group. This person will be the one responsible for paying Hubb's Corn Maze at arrival.
- Must have a minimum of 25 paying to book a field trip.
- If a minimum of 25 paying customers does not attend on field trip day, then a minimum of \$225 will apply.

Optional Add-Ons - Customize your field trip by adding any of the following for an additional fee:

- **Hubb's Express Train Ride- \$1 per person**
- **Plant a seed to take home and watch grow - \$2 per person**
- **Barrel Train Rides - \$1 per person**
- **Bag Lunch - \$5 per Lunch**
 - **Consists of Hot dog, Chips, Little Hug Juice**
 - **MUST know number of meals needed at least a week in advance.**
 - **Minimum of 25 lunches must be ordered**
 - **Substitute a bottled Pepsi product or bottled water for an additional \$1**

Steps in scheduling your Field Trip

- 1.** Hubb's Corn Maze is open Tuesday thru Friday for School Tours to be scheduled in advance. You can choose your tour from the following times. Each field trip can last up to 4 hours. Groups must arrive on time and depart on time in order not to flow into other groups' times
 - 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM
 - 9:30 AM – 1:30 PM
 - 10:30 AM – 2:30 PM

The above beginning times can be adjusted as long as the field ends by 2:30 PM. We make every effort to accommodate your group's time needs. This can be discussed at the time the field trip is scheduled.

- 2.** Decide if your class would like any add-ons.
- 3.** Book you field trip online or call 910-567-6709.

When to Arrive:

- We would like to have an accurate head count if possible 2-3 days prior to your field trip. This will allow us time to plan for your group better. You can email an accurate number of children, teachers, bus drivers, parents, and siblings to hubbscm@gmail.com
- Plan to arrive at Hubb's Corn Maze at least 15 minutes before your field trip is to begin. It is important that you arrive on time because there could be other groups in attendance.
- Someone will greet you at the bus upon arrival. It is best if the children remain on the bus until your group is checked-in. The activity schedule for your group will be available at check in time.
- If you are running late, please let us know by calling 910-564-6709.

Inclement Weather:

- When the weather appears questionable on the morning of your scheduled tour, please call Hubb's Corn Maze at 910-564-6709. We will let you know the current conditions. If weather is questionable here at Hubb's Corn Maze and we have not heard from your group, we will call the contact that was given to us at the time of your booking. If your tour is cancelled because of inclement weather, we will work to help you reschedule. We have set Mondays aside for rain dates.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL TEACHERS AND GROUP LEADERS:

- Please print map or call for directions before you come. Hubb's Corn Maze is located on Highway 421 North approx. 10 miles North of Clinton and 6 miles South of Spivey's Corner. Be sure the bus driver knows how to get here. It is important to know that the use of GPS will often take you to the wrong location when our physical address is entered. Please look on website for directions. Call us if necessary 910-564-6709.
- When you arrive, you designated leader will be told by the greeter where to check in. The leader should have the total headcount and payment. At that time, you will be given information on how to begin your adventure here at Hubb's Corn Maze.
- If a bathroom break is needed immediately upon arrival, please make sure that the greeter is aware of your group and proceed on to the rest rooms. We use portable toilets at our facility and we make every effort to insure that they are clean. They are cleaned often by the service company and multiple times throughout the day by our staff. Hand washing stations are also available. Please return to the "holding area" after the break before check-in.

- You may bring your own lunches. There are picnic tables under our new shelter and plenty of room on the grass to spread a blanket out for a picnic. (Lots of teachers brought large blankets for their kids to sit and picnic on in the past.)
- If you have a special needs class or student, please let us know in advance so that we may better provide for you, your student and class.
- Please discuss with students and parents that you will be visiting a farm and to dress appropriately. Play clothes and tennis shoes. The students should be dressed appropriate for whatever the outside temperature. If we have had recent rain, mud could be a possibility, so, old shoes are best. Sandals are not recommended.
- All school tour attendees (children, teachers, bus drivers, parents, and siblings) will be given a wristband. We do this for safety purposes. Your leader will get the wristbands at check-in time. We are not open to the public on days that we have field trips. With wristbands, we can easily identify the field trip attendees.
 - This year, we will be providing the public schools the wristbands in advance so that the bands can already be on the children, teachers, parents in advance. This will speed up the check-in process and provide for an easier reconciliation of attendees.
